Charlottetown PE – Starting on June 12, 2011 Credit Counselling Services of Atlantic Canada (CCSAC) will be hosting the Annual General Meeting (AGM) in Charlottetown for Credit Counselling Canada (CCC), the association for not-for-profit credit counselling agencies from across Canada.
